

Dr. Mujumdar now intends to strive towards converting Symbiosis University into an International University and also set up a Vishwa Gram, a Global Village on its university campus - where foreign and Indian students can live together in hostels, learn together in classrooms, play together on sports fields and eat together in cafeterias.





Themes for the day

Each day of the meet will focus on a particular theme. The three-day SAYPM commences on September 21st, which is observed as the UN International Day for World Peace.

DAY ONE

SIMC in association with Centre for Studies of Secularism & Society, Mumbai will explore the issue of COMMUNAL HARMONY AND PEACE in the South Asian region. The day has been devoted by the United Nations towards celebrating the ideals of peace both within and among all nations and peoples.

DAY TWO

Will look into YOUTH AFFAIRS AND POLITICS, and try to understand the role youth can play in a democracy. We try and throw light on the active involvement of the Youth in policy formulation and public opinion in the South Asian region.

DAY THREE

The event will conclude with discussions on ENVIRONMENT SUSTAINABILITY AND ENERGY EFFICIENCY in South Asia. The concluding day of the Meet discusses real issues like Carbon Footprints and Global Warming. Also, we release the South Asian Youth Charter which will be the product of our three days' deliberation.

Another major highlight of Day 3 will be the concluding General Assembly of the Model United Nations.





MODEL UNITED NATIONS (MUN)

Model United Nations (also Model UN or MUN) is an academic simulation of the United Nations that aims to educate participants about civics, effective communication, globalization and multilateral diplomacy. In Model UN, students take on roles as diplomats and participate in a simulated session of an intergovernmental organization (IGO). Participants research a country, take on roles as diplomats, investigate international issues, debate, deliberate, consult, and then develop solutions to world problems.

The MUN format at SAYPM due to time and resource constraints will only focus on three committees and two commissions of the General Assembly essentially the one's that make sense in the South Asian Perspective. A total of 60 delegations will represent their countries in the committees.

They are:

First Committee (Disarmament and International Security Committee) is concerned with disarmament and related international security questions;

Second Committee (Economic and Financial Committee) is concerned with economic questions;

Third Committee (Social, Humanitarian and Cultural Committee) deals with social and humanitarian issues;

Human Rights Commission deals with human rights issues;

Environment Commission deals with environment and climate change

Each committee in the first two days of proceedings would discuss an agenda each (informed to the delegations in advance), and hence pass a relevant resolution. All the five resolutions on the third day would be presented in the General Assembly, and finally passed there. The most important youth centric points from the final resolutions would be included in the SIMC YOUTH PEACE CHARTER, which would later be pitched to UN organizations to be presented at UN proceedings.

COVER PAGE




PARTICIPATION DETAILS

- ✦ To participate in SAYPM 2009, every contingent needs to fill the attached Registration Form and send it to the SAYPM 2009 participation team by 5th August 2009. No participation requests will be entertained after the prescribed deadline.
- ✦ All participants should necessarily be between the ages 18 to 30 years.
- ✦ All participants must be part of any college (UG and PG), university, or any other relevant organization from any of the nine South Asian countries i.e. India, Pakistan, Nepal, Bangladesh, Sri Lanka, Myanmar, Bhutan, Afghanistan and Maldives.
- ✦ A total of only 5 participants should apply for an MUN delegation with each one representing one committee, and other participants for the competitive and informal events.
- ✦ All participants are required to maintain the decorum of the college and any sort of indecent behaviour is unacceptable and may result in cancellation of the complete contingent with immediate effect.
- ✦ Liquor, cigarettes and other drugs are prohibited on the Lavale campus. Once here, you are requested to adhere to all the campus rules. Any flouting of rules will result in strict action against the participating contingent.
- ✦ All participants should be physically and mentally fit and in case of any medical history must carry medication, and also inform the organizer's in advance.
- ✦ **EVENT FEES**
The registration fee for each participant is Rs. 300, which would cover the accommodation expenses of the participant for all three days. SIMC will also be responsible for travel from (and to) Symbiosis S B Road Campus, Pune. All other expenses, including travel to Pune and the food has to be borne by the participants themselves. 
MENTOR ORGANISATIONS


